


# Mandolin Chords for Funny How Time Slips Away


Three D Major Chords:

**1** D (Dmaj, Dmajor, DM)  
1 - 3 - 5  
D - F# - A







One D7 Chord:


**1** D7 (Ddom7)

D - F# - A - C


Two G Major Chords:






A - C# - E





**2** A (Amaj, Amajor, AM)

A - C# - E




One E7 Chord:

E - G# - B - D





And finally, as an option, an E5 chord that may be substituted for the E7:




**E5 (E, Emaj, Emajor, EM)**


1 - 3 - 5  
E - G# - B
